



Potato Stamps

What you'll need:

- potato
- knife
- paint
- paper



Step 1: Wash and scrub the potato.



Step 2: Cut the potato in half. Each half can become one stamp.



Step 3: Trace and cut a design into the potato's face (about 1/4 inch deep cut).



Step 4: Cut the surrounding potato away from the design. Be extra careful around corners or small pieces of the design.



Step 5: Press the potato into the paint and then onto the paper. Repeat!
